

Preparing The Outside of Your Home

- 1. Cut the lawn regularly if you normally cut your lawn every 2 weeks, cut it every week during the marketing period.
- 2. Edge the lawn up the driveway and along the sidewalks for a more finished appearance.
- 3. Eliminate grass and weeds from driveway and walkways. Pressure wash if necessary to remove dirt and mold.
- 4. Trim all shrubbery and remove low lying and dead tree limbs.
- 5. Plant flowers in the front yard and spread decorative mulch around flower and tree beds. Pull weeds as they appear.
- 6. Fertilize your lawn and water it regularly, to keep it lush and green.
- 7. Clean fish ponds, fountains & birdbaths.
- 8. Remove debris such as limbs, construction materials and flower pots.
- 9. Clean out, and if necessary, repair gutters and downspouts.
- 10. Remove or reduce excessive yard ornaments.
- 11. Paint any trim that is blistering.
- 12. Repaint or re-stain the front door to create a welcoming impression.
- 13. Replace or repair torn screens from windows and doors.
- 14. Remove spider webs, insect and wasp nests.
- 15. Clean porch and patio furniture and arrange attractively. A couple potted flowers can create a cheerful entry.
- 16. Repair fences and gates, and brighten up with fresh paint or stain.
- 17. Replace or paint weathered or broken outdoor light fixtures.
- 18. Wash all windows and glass doors.
